

The verb venir and a + time

- 1 The verb **venir** means *to come*. In the present tense its endings are like those of **tener**, except for the **nosotros** and **vosotros** forms.

yo vengo	nosotros(as) venimos
tú vienes	vosotros(as) venís
Ud., él, ella viene	Uds., ellos, ellas vienen

- 2 To say at what time something happens, put the preposition **a** before the **time**.

¿**A qué hora** vienes al colegio?

At what time do you come to school?

Vengo **a las ocho en punto**.

I come at eight o'clock.

¿**A qué hora** es la clase de álgebra?

At what time is algebra class?

Es **a la una de la tarde**.

It's at one in the afternoon.
